The following is an update following the Board's meeting on Monday night.



## 1. Fixture finalisation

The season start date for the Ballarat playing area was discussed. Given the following:

- some clubs are still only starting to get members back around their clubs and starting to practise
- a number of clubs are still updating and trialling COVID protocols
- there is still some uncertainty about the road-map date for 'opening up' and returning to community sport
- there is still a lack of information around a vaccination policy or associated procedures the Board believes that a prudent decision for our clubs and their members is to give ourselves an extra week to prepare for the season.

# Therefore, the Ballarat playing area pennant season will begin on Saturday, 13th November.

- The season will run for 14 weeks with 3 weeks of finals. Pennant will be played on November 20<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, 23<sup>rd</sup> November (formerly the Victoria Open week).
